APPENDIX I Contd...

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ECG should be mandatory for those aged over 40 years. Blood Pressure should be normal (below 140/90 mm/Hg).

- (j) **Respiratory System:** Should not ordinarily be suffering from any respiratory disease such as P. T. B., Cancer Bronchiectasis. There shall be no acute disability of the lungs nor any active disease of the structures of the mediastinum or pleura. Active pulmonary tuberculosis shall be considered as disqualification. Healed lesions of pulmonary tuberculosis is not a disqualification, extensive deformity of thoracic cage may be assessed as unfit.
- (k) **Central Nervous System:** Candidates should not be suffering from Chronic nervous diseases including mental diseases.
- (l) **Gastro Intestinal Tract:** No palpable tumor or chronic Hepatosplenomegaly.
- (m) **Genitor Urinary System:** Hernia and Hydro ale to be operated before fitness. The urine should not contain any abnormal elements, which may be considered as pathological.
- (n) **Extremities:** No varicose veins. Should not be suffering from physical handicap with reference to skeletal and joints.
- (o) **Skin:** Should not be suffering from any chronic diseases like Hansen's Tuberculosis, Eczema, and chronic Ulcers, etc., Candidates with chronic Lymphadenopathy are unfit.
- (p) **Lymph Glands:** As per the minimum standards in the opinion of the doctor examining the candidates.
- (q) **Females:** Pregnant women shall not be appointed till the confinement is over. Chronic diseases, which in the opinion of the doctor, examining the candidates, will interfere with the job adversely, will be a disqualification.

II POSTS REQUIRING SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:

- (a) **Height:** Minimum height should be more than 5 ft for drivers, which may be determined by the Chief Medical Superintendent/Senior Medical Officers of the Division concerned.
- (b) **Colour vision:** Defect in colour vision for drivers, crane operators and control tower operator is a disqualification.
- (c) **E N T:** Person required to work in noisy environment such, as test house should have the basic audiometry done.
- (d) **Skin:** Person required to work in jobs involving handling of acids and alcohol, should not have dry skin.
- (e) **Hygiene:** Personnel working in canteens should be examined for personal hygiene. For this examination, special attention is to be devoted with regard to motion examination investigation against VD, P.T.B. and skin diseases are to be kept in view.

III PERIODICAL MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS:**a) Individuals working on health hazardous jobs**

Employees who works in the following jobs and those who work in the following department are to be examined periodically, say once in six months or at such intervals, as the Chief Medical Superintendent / Sr. Medical Officer consider necessary: -

- Individuals working in battery section
- Electroplater
- Painter
- Welder
- Radium Dial Painter
- Individuals exposed to noise, dust like Silica, Metallic dusts.
- Individuals engaged on inspection- Magnaflex etc.
- Individuals working in Plastic Department
- Grinders in Polishing section
- Individuals working in Blue Printing Section
- Individuals engaged on fire extinguishing work
- Individuals engaged in cabin pressurisation
- Individuals engaged on heat- treatment
- Individuals exposed to X-rays and Gamma rays.

Employees who are engaged on jobs which are considered as health hazardous or dangerous operation under any provisions of law are to be examined at such intervals and in such manner as laid down under the said provisions. If no procedure is laid down under such provisions, they are to be examined as in the case of employees mentioned above. They are to be examined for general examination and where necessary with reference to the special requirement of the post. A specimen form used for the purpose of medical examination is enclosed as Appendix-II.

b) Individuals whose health is a concern for other Workmen.

Personnel such as workmen in canteens, drivers and/or traffic controllers, whose health and physical fitness are concern of other workmen from the point of health or safe working are to be subjected to periodical medical examination, say once in 6 to 12 months.

While examining the canteen workers, specific attention is to be given for personnel hygiene and investigation are to be conducted for any ailment/disease which might directly or indirectly spread diseases among canteen visitors. For this purpose motion examination and investigation against VD, PTB, chronic skin diseases are to be kept in view. Medical officer nominated for the purpose is to make periodical visits to canteens and if he come across any person suffering from any ailment and considers that he is to be examined and investigated, such examination may be taken up at short intervals.

While examining the drivers special attention is to be devoted with regard to eye sight particularly colour vision. For traffic controller are to be examined as per standard laid down by ICAO/DGCA
